The Code of Professional Conduct for Election Administrators (Code) applies to the following election officers: returning officers (ROs), assistant returning officers (AROs), additional assistant returning officers (AAROs) and field liaison officers (FLOs). Election Commission of India's Model Code of Conduct is a set of guidelines issued by the Election Commission of India for conduct of political parties and candidates during elections mainly with respect to speeches, polling day, polling booths, portfolios, election manifestos, processions and general conduct.

But the code of conduct for members of the European Commission states that they “shall abstain from making public statements or interventions on behalf of any political party or organization of the social partners of which they are members,” except when they stand for election or participate in a vote.

History of Codes of Judicial Conduct. The American Bar Association first issued rules governing the conduct of judges in 1924. Named the Canons of Judicial Ethics, these guidelines were designed to instruct judges about the ethical framework in which they worked. Through national circulation, most states adopted some version of the canons.

The code of conduct stated that, “Except for personnel deployed on covert operations, all personnel on electoral assignment will ensure a neat turnout in their prescribed uniform and name tags, which must be identifiable to the public, stating that ICCES may from time to time approve a common means of identification for all security agencies on election duty.
