Example: Represent the solution set of inequality $x + 4 \leq 8$, where 'x' is a whole number. Solution: Subtracting 4 from both sides of given inequality, $x \leq 4$. Since x is a whole number, Solution set = {0,1,2,3,4}

Now divide each part by 2 (a positive number, so again the inequalities don't change): $-6 < -x < 3$. Now multiply each part by -1 . Because we are multiplying by a negative number, the inequalities change direction. $6 > x > -3$. And that is the solution! But to be neat it is better to have the smaller number on the left, larger on the right.

An inequality compares two values, showing if one is less than, greater than, or simply not equal to another value. $a \neq b$ says that a is not equal to b $a < b$ says that a is less than b $a > b$ says that a is greater than b (those two are known as strict inequality) $a \leq b$ means that a is less than or equal to b
