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The Quality Of Measurements A

Because quality is a concept, and too vague to measure directly, to measure quality meaningfully, we have to unpack it first. Inspired by Douglas Hubbard's clarification chain, from his brilliant book How To Measure Anything (and discussed in this article about measuring design success) is this basic guideline I use to make vague concepts measurable :

5 Steps to Measure the Quality of Anything

Quality measurement is a type of evaluation that is used in many industries. Example: The Environmental Protection Agency measures the quality of the air in the surrounding environment by analyzing the presence of specific compounds that are known to cause pollution.

Quality measures
